Executive Summary

The ANZDATA Advisory Committee and Clinical Working Groups agreed to the new data collection elements and these were implemented within the Online Electronic Data Collection tool (https://services.anzdata.org.au) and as a new A3 Survey and ancillary (A4) paper forms. Data Element

The variable 'Racial Origin' within the ANZDATAPatients table, is no longer collected and in place is the item Ethnicity. As a patient can identify with more than one ethnicity, there is a primary and secondary Ethnicity variable ('Ethnicity 1' and 'Ethnicity 2'). The Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) and the NZ Stats ethnicity classifications have been mapped to these fields. This enables an expanded list to be used for reporting patient ethnicity.

Collection of Data Element

Data is collected in real-time for <u>NEW</u> patient registration and at survey if missed at the time of registration. All reported Racial Origin and Ethnicity codes collected prior to 2019 remains unchanged on the database.




Figure 2 - Screen View - Ethnicity Collection
