

# Change to Treatment Codes (Convention and Quotidian data no longer being collected)

#### **Executive Summary**

ANZDATA will no longer be collecting quotidian or conventional dialysis. As a result, codes BC, BQ, DC, DQ, FC, FQ, YC, YQ will cease. When registering patients or changing patient dialysis treatments a single letter code B, D, F, Y is available.

The ANZDATA Advisory Committee and Haemodialysis Working Group agreed to this change in data collection element. The new data variable is available in real time within the Online Electronic Data Collection tool (<u>https://services.anzdata.org.au</u>) and the A3 Survey Paper Form from Survey 73 - 2022

#### Background

The Registry has been collecting conventional and quotidian data since 2011 survey. This historically required a 2 letter code in treatments for validation with the dialysis screen and analysis.


#### **Data Element**

Data is collected in real-time. Historical use of the quotidian and conventional codes will remain within the patient's treatment record. The following codes will apply going forward:

- B Hospital HD
- D Satellite HD
- F Home HD
- Y HD Community House
