### General Member

Members of the Nephrology community are invited to join the working group through the Expression of Interest process. Members are selected to provide a range of skills including leadership, sub-specialty expertise, registry data analysis and teamwork with the aim of ANZDATA-based research to maximise the scientific output of ANZDATA, and to continually review the scientific basis of data collection.

Appointments to the Working Group should aim to include Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander professional people expert in clinical care, epidemiology, policy and health systems. We recognise the limited Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander workforce in nephrology with these attributes, and welcome collaboration by those with non-nephrology clinical expertise willing to collaborate.

The Working Group seeks to appoint Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people as members and as convenor whenever this expertise is available, to work alongside non-Indigenous members appointed to the Working group. The working group will have a special relationship with the Indigenous Community Reference Group (see separate Terms of Reference), and it is anticipated that some members of the CRG will also be members of the Working Group.

The Working Group will have a role in providing advice to the ANZDATA Executive and operations around

- Appropriate mechanisms for respecting and enabling the principles of Indigenous Data Governance.
- Assessment and handling of data requests that focus on aspects of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples' Health.

### Advanced Trainee Member

RACP Advanced trainees in Nephrology will be invited to join working groups through the Expression of Interest process as follows:

- EOIs will occur annually with one advanced trainee accepted per working group each year for an initial 2-year term
- Maximum of 2 trainees per working group
- Selection will be based on for (i) demonstrated data analysis skills and (ii) current involvement in ANZDATA projects
- Letter of support from RACP supervisor or Head of Unit for Advanced trainee membership is a pre-requisite for application
