

NEW PATIENTS

PATIENTS COMMENCING TREATMENT IN 1996

AUSTRALIA

In Australia, the number of patients with end stage renal failure starting treatment has risen steadily over the past six years from 984 patients (1991) to 1405 patients (1996): 57 to 77 per million respectively. See Table 8. Non Caucasoid (Europid) patients have fallen to 17% (1996), 19% (1995). In relation to the general population in each age group, those 65-74 years increased in 1996 to 312 per million (257 per million 1995). See Table 9.




Figure 28**New Patients - Australia****Figure 29****Age of New Patients - Australia 1996****Figure 30****Acceptance of New Patients 1987 - 1996**

There was only a 1.5% increase (22 patients) in the number commencing treatment compared to 1995. Incidence rates for the previous five years are shown in Figure 28.

Males comprised 57% of patients (58% in 1995). See Table 12.

The median age of all patients was 59.4 years (59.1 years males, 60.3 years females). Modal age group was 65-74 years (males and females). Mean age was 55.5 years. Age range was from 4 months to 88.5 years. See Table 7 and Figure 29.

The age group specific new patient rates are shown in Figure 30.

Most patients were Caucasoid (Europid) 83%, 6.5% Aboriginal, 1% Pacific Islander, 5% Asian and 4% other.

There was a fall in new patients in the age group 45-64 years, representing a reduction from a rapid annual rise in this age group in the previous years.

NEW ZEALAND

In New Zealand, the number has risen from 215 patients (1991) to 285 patients (1996): 62 to 78 per million respectively. Non Caucasoid patients represented 51% (1996), 49% (1995). Median age was 52.4 years. See Table 8.

The intake remained similar, 285 patients (78 per million): 287 (79 per million in 1995). See Figure 31.

Males comprised 55% of patients (60% 1995). See Table 12.

The median age of patients was 52.7 years for males and 52.4 years for females. Modal age group was 55-64 years for both males and females. Mean age had decreased to 50.4 years. Age range was from 8 months to 79.5 years. See Table 7 and Figure 32.

The age distribution showed a decrease (22%) in adults 45-54 years old, and also in young adults 25-34 years. Those 65-74 years increased to 17%. The age group specific rates are shown in Figure 33.

Half the patients were Caucasoid (Europid) 49%; 33% Maori, 11% Pacific Islander and 3% Asian.

The comparative annual rates of treatment in relation to race show a 2-4 fold excess in the Aboriginal, Maori and Pacific Islanders compared to the Caucasian group. See Australia Figure 34 and New Zealand Figure 35.

AUSTRALIAN STATES

The number of new patients increased in all States. The lowest intake rates were Western Australia (66 per million) and Tasmania (63 per million).

Excluding analgesic nephropathy the highest intakes were Northern Territory (253 per million) and Victoria (76 per million).

In the modal age group 65-74 years the lowest rate was in South Australia (194 per million), the highest New South Wales/ACT (369 per million) and Northern Territory (720 per million).

The median, mean ages and age range are shown in Table 7.

New Patients (Per Million) New Zealand 1990 - 1996



New Patients (285)



Acceptance of New Patients 1987 - 1996 Age Specific Rates - New Zealand



New Acceptances by Race Australia 1988 - 1996


